The events are to preserve and promote the history, culture and legacy of Comanche, Native Americans, Cynthia Ann Parker and her son Quanah.

The love story of Cynthia Ann and Peta Nocona still fascinates the hearts of young and old from the four directions of this great land.

This year's powwow will be a 2 day event on Friday, June 11 and Saturday, June 12.

Other events include a journey to the home site of Quanah and memorial service at the post cemetery, Fort Sill, OK.

Attendees will be encouraged to visit the Comanche Nation Headquarters, Comanche Nation Museum, Comanche Visitors Center, Comanche Casino, Apache Casino, post cemetery, Geronimo's grave, Fort Sill Museum and Wichita Mountains Wildlife Refuge.

The late Mr. Herbert W. Woesner Jr., a legend in his own right, made a significant contribution to the legacy of Quanah. His reply to our thought of not having events one year was "why would you not want to have a good thing." We carry on with his wish and legacy.

All events are open to the public. We hope you will join us.
